

The public has lost confidence in the health and safety of nuclear power, after the 2011 Fukushima disaster in Japan. Today, no nuclear plant is under construction in the United States, and only one currently operates (in Vermont). Twenty-one reactors have been permanently retired, resulting in a steady decline in the number of reactors in operation, from 80 in 1996 to 44 today. Nuclear power has become radioactive and unpopular. At the same time, climate change and public health issues, including the health effects of chemical exposures, have

increased concerns about the impact of nuclear power on air quality and public health. As the nuclear industry struggles to stay afloat, it has turned to funding climate denial. Unfortunately, the public has become familiar with the industry's campaign to deny climate science and to block policy solutions. Yet, the nuclear industry is well funded. In July of this year, the International Energy Agency (IEA) released its "world energy outlook," predicting a slow-down in new nuclear power plant construction in the coming years. We are used to hearing about new nuclear power plants in the U.S. The Obama administration has been pushing for the construction of additional nuclear reactors. So, too, have the Chinese and the Russians. But, according to the IEA report, the U.S. is no longer planning any new reactors. The IEA expects new nuclear power plant construction will slow to a crawl, with only four projects underway in the U.S. By the end of the decade, it projects, no new plants will be under construction. "Nuclear power is under pressure," says Janez Potočnik, the IEA's vice president for environment and energy. "A nuclear plant is extremely expensive to build, requiring a decade to plan, a year to build and years of operation. The business model is much more complicated 82157476af
